EAST LANSING, Mich.—The MSU Science Festival has announced the dates for the 6<sup>th</sup> annual event that explores the fields of science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM).

Mark your calendars for **April 6-22**, to experience “Science...Live!” featuring more than 200 activities spanning 17 days. The Festival features events ranging from talks, demonstrations, tours, open houses, hands-on activities to a special event presentation by an international scientist.

Events are slated across Michigan with a concentration of activities in East Lansing, Grand Rapids, Ann Arbor, Kalamazoo, and Detroit areas.
